## What is microblading?

Microblading is a form of cosmetic tattoo artistry that involves manually implanting pigment into the skin, to produce crisp hair strokes that perfectly mimic a natural brow hair. Eyebrow embroidery & 3D hair stroke methods are all forms of microblading. It is done using an extremely fine and precise manual blade.
